The Department for State Policy in Civil Aviation of the Ministry of Transport of the Russian Federation presents its compliments to the Aeronautical Authorities of the Republic of Turkey and has the honor to propose to agree as follow by the exchange of letters for 2 consecutive IATA Seasons starting from IATA Summer-2022.

- 1. Increase the number of designated air carriers on the routes Moscow Dalaman and v.v. and Moscow Bodrum and v.v. to 3 (three) air carries for each Side, with the limitation of 7 (seven) frequencies per week assigned to the third designated air carrier of each Side.
- 2. Increase the number of designated air carriers on the route Saint-Petersburg Istanbul and v.v. to 2 (two) air carries for each Side, with the limitation of 7 (seven) frequencies per week assigned to the second designated air carrier of each Side.

In case of your agreement we propose that this letter and your positive response to it to be considered as an agreement between our Aeronautical Authorities.
