

**Agreed Minutes
of the meeting of the Working Group of Experts
of the Aeronautical Authorities
of the Russian Federation and the Federal Republic of Germany**

The Group of aviation experts of the Russian Federation (hereinafter referred to as the Russian Delegation) and the Federal Republic of Germany (hereinafter referred to as the German Delegation) met in Moscow, Russia on 31 May and 1 June 2016 to discuss matters related to further development and strengthening of the bilateral air transport relations between their respective countries.

Both Delegations agreed about the following:


1. The winter flight program of the second German all-cargo carrier, non-designated for Transsiberian route operations, mentioned in paragraph 2a) of Protocol signed on 23 January 2014, consists of 21 (twenty one) weekly one way charter operations along Transsiberian route network. These operations are subject to standard requirements applicable to any Transsiberian system flights.
2. The applications for operations of the German all-cargo air carrier mentioned above shall be submitted in accordance with the respective national requirements for charter operations. The permission shall be issued for an entire IATA season.

Entry into Force

These Agreed minutes will come into effect on the date of signature. Provisions of the previous arrangements not covered in these Agreed minutes will remain in effect.
