

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITIES
OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION
AND
THE PEOPLE'S DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC
OF ALGERIA

The Civil Aviation Authorities of the Russian Federation and the People's Democratic Republic of Algeria discussed the bilateral relations in the field of civil aviation based on the Air Services Agreement signed on February 9, 2008 between the two countries.

Both delegations expressed desire to advance their aviation relationship in a spirit of cooperation for their mutual benefits.

The following understandings were reached between the Civil Aviation Authorities:

1. Traffic Rights

The designated airline(s) of both Contracting Parties are allowed to operate up to 14 weekly frequencies on each city pair for passengers or in combination flights with 3rd and 4th freedom traffic rights without any restriction on aircraft type.

The designated airline(s) of both Contracting Parties are allowed to operate up to 14 weekly frequencies on each city pair for all-cargo flights with 3rd and 4th freedom traffic rights without any restriction on aircraft type.

2. Route Schedule

The designated airlines of the **Russian Federation** shall be entitled to operate international scheduled air services in both directions on the routes specified hereunder:

Points of origin	Intermediate points	Points of destination	Points beyond
Any points in the Russian Federation	Points in third countries*	Algiers, Oran and other points in People's Democratic Republic of Algeria*	Caracas and other points in third countries*

* Other points shall be subject to an agreement between the Civil Aviation Authorities of the States of the parties.

The designated airline of the **People's Democratic Republic of Algeria** shall be entitled to operate scheduled international air services in both directions on the routes specified hereafter:

Points of origin	Intermediate points	Points of destination	Points beyond
Any points in People's Democratic Republic of Algeria	Points in third countries*	Moscow, Saint-Petersburg and other points in the Russian Federation*	Beijing and other points in third countries*

* Other points shall be subject to an agreement between the Civil Aviation Authorities of the States of the parties.

3. Entry into Force

The provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding shall come into effect on the date of its signature.

Arrangements, not covered by this Memorandum, shall remain in force.

Done on 5th December, 2023, in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.


